About Us

WYO was established in 1958 and is a self-funding voluntary organisation whose income is generated solely from public performances and annual membership fees. Many former members have gone on to forge careers within the world of music, including conducting and performing with the world's top orchestras, arranging and composing music as well as playing for West End shows.

There are two orchestras due to varying age, ability and experience. The Junior Orchestra (grades 1- 4) has an approximate age range of 8 - 14 years and the Senior Orchestra (grade 5+) has an age range of 12 - 21 years.

Rehearsals take place every Friday evening throughout the year at the Boulevard United Reformed Church. The Junior Orchestra rehearses 6pm - 7pm and the Senior Orchestra 7pm - 9pm.
